COVID Information

Odyssey School Leaders in collaboration with Green Apple School Management have been working on our plan to ensure that our students and staff are able to return to campus and remain safe, clean, and healthy. We have organized our rooms and the cafeteria to allow for social distancing in all rooms to the degree practicable. We have procedures for checking temperatures for all students and staff, along with procedures and guidelines that we will follow if we have someone that gets sick. Our cleaning procedures have been reviewed and enhanced and we have hired additional staff to assist in keeping our campus clean and disinfected throughout the day.

One direction travel will decrease the amount of intermingling of students during class change. The cafeteria will be set up with students facing one direction, and with fewer students per table. Every classroom has already been organized with desks and/or tables to allow students to be successful while ensuring they remain healthy. We have also restructured our arrival and dismissal to decrease groups of students congregating in different areas.

We will continue to monitor the plan that Brevard Public Schools provides as well as the CDC guidelines for schools and will adapt as needed.

COVID Expectations – for sick students

If a student arrives to school with a temperature, or becomes sick during the day, they will be quarantined in a designated area of the clinic, families will be contacted, and the student is expected to be picked up immediately to eliminate exposure to other students or faculty members. A doctor note will be expected to allow for the return of the child to school.

Early Release Days

We will continue early release days on Friday's throughout the school year which is consistent Brevard County School District's schedule.

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School Hours

For the 2019-2020 school year, Odyssey Charter Jr. / Sr. High School stu¬dents will begin the day at 8:55am; the school day will end at 4:08pm. Our early release dismissals will now be every Friday at 2:45pm.

School Visitors

Due to COVID-19 and current conditions, we will not have any school visitors, including family members, until later in the fall when it is determined to be safe. As the year progresses, we will continue to monitor and evaluate the school's health and safety conditions for our Titans and our school community. We thank you for your help and support in making sure the safety of all our students and staff continues to be our priority.

Uniform Policy (Grades 6-12):

School Uniform Policy: 2019-2020 Updates

All Odyssey Charter School students are required to wear a school uniform. Our uniforms can be purchased from our uniform provider: **All Uniform Wear** (*Discount coupons will be available during Summer Registration at all campuses.*)

- All students are required to wear full-length solid colored pants, shorts, skirts or 'skorts'. Inappropriately rolling or altering the pants in any way is in direct violation of the dress code. Shorts, skirts and 'skorts' length must be at least mid-thigh.
- Pants, shorts, skirts and 'skorts' that are too big or too tight, as determined by Administration, are not acceptable and will be deemed in violation of the uniform code.
- Students must wear a collared polo shirt or dress shirt. Student polo's and dress shirts must be a solid color and in accordance with the individual schools' uniform guide. All shirts must bear the School logo.
- Any attire and/or backpacks with any inappropriate logos or displays are prohibited.
- All hats, scarves, and bandanas are prohibited on school property.
- Shoes must be closed in the back.
- If a student chooses or needs to wear a jacket or sweatshirt due to cold weather, it must be solid Black, Blue, or Gray.
- Students who choose to dress out in P.E. must wear appropriate shirts and shorts. Students must change back to regular attire before leaving class. Some lockers will be provided in the gym for students that want to change for physical education.

Wellness

- Free Breakfast and Lunch: We believe that fresh, seasonal, local, sustainably grown foods are a primary and recommended source of nutrition for growing, high-achieving children and we offer these FREE daily in our healthy café at breakfast and lunch times. YES, WE SAID FREE. However, we do need every family to still fill out the income verification form at registration. Please encourage your child take advantage of our healthy and delicious meals. We believe it enhances our students' academic and behavioral development.
- Clear Water Bottles (There are water filling stations throughout the campus, but NOT water fountains.)
- **Deep cleaning** will take place daily as well as sanitizing throughout the day
- Masks are optional for students/staff, but must meet uniform guidelines
- There will not any **field trips** within the first 3 months of school
- Any student with a **fever of 100^o** or higher will be required to be picked up immediately

Bus Transportation

In preparation for the upcoming school year Odyssey Transportation is excited to announce we are now working with 3DEZROUTING!! Parents/guardians will be able to update any address changes that might alter a student's bus route through this website. We are happy that this will assist us in keeping you better informed throughout the school year.

Registering your student for school bus transportation will now be handled online for easy access, and the school will be able to provide you with updates on your student's application as well as information on their assigned bus and route. We will also be able to send you important information with any transportation changes or updates that might affect your student throughout the school year.

Registration is required for ALL (new and returning) school bus riders to ensure that your student is routed and assigned to the closest bus stop available. Bus transportation is available for students whose residence is located over two miles from the school they attend. Please register on our transportation website as a parent/guardian, using this link: https://www.ezrouting.com/odysseyfl.

You will need the following information to register:

- 1. Your student's name.
- 2. Student District ID for Brevard. (The same ID used in BPS Focus)
- 3. Your student's current physical address.
- 4. Current Parent/Guardian home and/or cell phone numbers.
- 5. Current Parent/Guardian email address.

This information will only be used for transportation routing and communication purposes, so accuracy is important.

Odyssey Charter Schools provide bus transportation to students who live between two and four miles from the school (some farther than 4 miles). Bus registration is online this year and computers will be available during summer registration. **Each student is allowed one designated bus stop**. Changes to assigned routes or bus transportation needs will not be permitted until a new registration form is completed by a parent/guardian with proper ID.

Odyssey's Transportation Department will operate in accordance with CDC Guidelines We thank you in advance for your cooperation in keeping our children safe and healthy. Please take the time to review and discuss the following safety procedures and expectations.

- Students are encouraged to practice social distancing at their assigned bus stops.
- Students are encouraged to wear an optional mask during bus routes.
- Students will use hand sanitizer as they enter and exit the bus.
- Any students with an elevated temperature will be seated in the designated area in the front, parents will be contacted, and students will need to be picked up from the school.
- Siblings will sit together during all routes.
- Students will exit the bus one row at a time from front of the bus to the back of the bus, during arrival to the school in the morning.
- Be mindful and practice good hygiene and manners.

Summer Readings

All Odyssey Charter School students are required to read the English Language Arts, grade-specific novel(s) each summer. The list was given to students before the end of the school year and is also available on our website: www.odysseycharterschool.com. Students in grades 6-12, who wish to check-out their novels, can do so throughout the summer with Ms. Thompson in our front office. Students can expect assignments related to the specific summer novel when they begin the 2020-2021 school year.

GATEWay & Honors Opportunities

We offer a variety of coursework geared to challenge all students beginning in 6th grade. In addition to Advanced or "Honors" courses in all core classes, we also offer the following GATEWay electives: Coding, Gaming, Commercial Art, Engineering, Robotics, Marine Science, Forensics, Biotechnology, Digital Art, Advanced Placement Art, Advanced Placement English, Advanced Placement History, Advanced Placement Science, Advanced Placement Math, Honors Performing Art groups (Band, Chorus, Orchestra)

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Dual Enrollment & Advanced Placement

We encourage eligible students to enroll in Advanced Placement courses as well as in Dual Enrollment courses by their Junior Year in order to earn college credits. The minimum GPA for Dual Enrollment is a 3.0. All interested students should meet our Dual Enrollment Specialist, Ms. Kim Havet, havetk@odysseycharterschool.com to schedule testing for acceptance.

Additional Academic Support Opportunities

Success Saturday - Starting around the third Saturday of the school year, students are invited to participate in weekly Success Saturday sessions from 9:00–11:30 AM. During this time, students work with certified teachers in small groups to review previously taught material. During Success Saturday, teachers focus on reteaching the academic standards that students have not mastered and provide tutoring to small groups of students in the areas in which they need additional reinforcement. There is NO CHARGE for this program and it is open to all students in grades 6-12.

Finish Friday - Each Friday from 2:45–4:00 PM, students are invited by their teachers to attend Finish Friday to complete assignments not finished during the week. If invited, students are required to attend. Teacher assistants support students in small groups. There is NO CHARGE for this program and it is open to all students in grades 6-12.

Success Summer - Each summer, students can attend Success Summer for acceleration or credit recovery. Students with a GPA of 3.5 or above in grades 8-12 desiring acceleration can submit requests to take courses online to move more quickly through their high school program of study. Students in need of credit recovery are asked to attend online courses to ensure they stay on target for graduation. These courses are free of charge and are led by a certified, online teacher, as well as a teaching assistant from the school.

Boot Camps - Each summer, based on student need, 2-week special boot camps are opened to help prepare students for specific courses, such as Algebra 1. These camps are led by a certified teacher in the area of the camp and are free of charge to invited students.
