# **Tardy Policy**

Elementary students are expected to be in their seats and ready to learn by 8:00 AM. If you arrive at 8:00 or later, parents must park and walk their child into the office, sign them in, and have a tardy slip issued for admittance to class. Parents, please do not park in the fire lane - this is a safety concern. We thank you for making the effort to have your students to class on time each and every day.

# **Early Check-out for Students**

Parents, we are asking that if you need to check out your elementary student early, that you do so by 2:00 PM on a regular dismissal day and by 12:45 PM on an early release day. It can become a dismissal safety concern when students are checked out too close to the dismissal time. Students may be checked out of school by their parent or legal guardian. If you are checking your student out, please present your valid state-issued photo identification at our front office. Please remember that we do not take dismissal changes over the phone. All changes made to your child's normal means of transportation home are required in writing. We would also like to encourage you to make appointments for your child outside of our school hours in order to maximize your child's learning time and minimize classroom disruptions for all students. # **Dress Out of Uniform Days**

OCS Students are to be in uniform daily, except for the last Friday of the month (our Dress Out of Uniform Day). Students are welcome to dress out of uniform but must follow the Brevard County Dress Code outlined in the Brevard County Student Handbook. Birthday recognition and any related activities are at the discretion of each teacher. ### **School Hours and Car Loop Reminders**

#### **Safety First at Arrival & Dismissal**

The school's car loop certainly has its limitations and we thank you for your patience and support during arrival and dismissal. Our school hours are from 8:00 a.m. until 2:35 p.m. for Grades K-2 and 8:00 a.m. until 2:50 p.m. for Grades 3-5 on regular dismissal days. On Early Release Fridays, Grades K-2 students are released at 1:15 p.m. and Grades 3-5 students are released at 1:30 p.m. We appreciate your willingness to share the space with other parents as you travel and merge through the loop. Please continue to exercise caution and safety during arrival and dismissal. Our children are counting on you!

#### Remember to follow these tips to keep traffic flowing and students safe in our car loop:

- Be sure to honor the 5mph posted speed limit
- Refrain from using cell phones
- Always display your GREEN car loop pick-up sign in your window. It is recommended for you to use a clip clothes hanger to hang sign from your rearview mirror so it is easily viewed by staff in the car loop.
- Remember, when turning onto Eldron, RIGHT turns ONLY during arrival and dismissal times
- If you park on Raleigh, please be sure to leave the sidewalk clear. Students and families need the sidewalk to walk safely.
- Please watch out for pedestrians in your moving vehicle
- · Reserve disabled parking for vehicles with disabled parking permits
- Always drop off children at the designated orange cones nowhere else in the carloop area or on main roads such as Eldron Blvd.
- Do not use Pineapple Cove's parking area
- When walking with your student on school sidewalks, students are encouraged to walk on the side of the sidewalk AWAY from the driveway/street (closest to the mulch and fence) and parent or other adult chaperone on the side of traffic.

The car loop is the safest and most efficient way to drop off and pick up your child. During our busiest times, it takes just about 10 minutes from the driveway entrance to the driveway exit during the car loop. It takes time at the beginning of the year for our parent, student, and staff community to become accustomed to arrival and dismissal routines. We ask for your patience and understanding during the beginning of the year where these times may be prolonged as we adjust to the school year. Please note that if you have not entered the driveway by 7:50 your child will likely be late to class.

Additional Transportation Note: Change of transportation must be submitted in writing in order for the change to be valid. This stipulation is to ensure student safety.

# **Healthy Café**

We are pleased to announce that all students that attend our schools receive 1 free breakfast and 1 free lunch per day this school year. The only money your child will need for the meal program will be for the purchase of a la carte items or extra entrees. ### **Volunteer System – Raptor**

All volunteers must complete the volunteer application process and go through a background screening prior to starting any volunteer activity at OCS. As a potential volunteer, you will be asked to provide the information necessary to perform a background check. You may not be on campus as a volunteer until your background check has been completed and you have been approved as a volunteer. OCS is participating in the district-wide Volunteer and Visitor check in system to add additional security to our campuses. The system, called Raptor, scans state-issued photo licenses and ID cards, required for admittance to the building past the front office.

### **Read Aloud Program**

The Read Aloud program is a wonderful way for parents to fulfill their volunteer hours while supporting their students academically, socially, and emotionally. In 1983, the U.S. Department of Education report "Becoming a Nation of Readers" found that, "the single most important activity for building the knowledge required for eventual success in reading is reading aloud to children."

To participate in the Read Aloud program, parents should spend at least 15 minutes reading aloud literature to their child that is about two grades above their independent reading level. Then complete the Read Aloud log which can be provided by your classroom teacher or through the front office. Next turn in your log at the end of each month to your classroom teacher or to the front office and you will receive volunteer hours for the time spent reading aloud to your child

#### Grievance Procedures

Step 1: Request Teacher conference to clarify issue

Step 2: Contact Principal if unresolved with the teacher

Step 3: \*\*Contact Board Designated Parent Representative

Step 4: Contact the President of the Governing Board

Step 5: Present issue at the next monthly Board Meeting if unresolved

Step 6: Seek mediation with the Sponsor
