### BUS SAFETY

Please partner with us to be sure your student stays safe and receives uninterrupted instruction time while on campus!

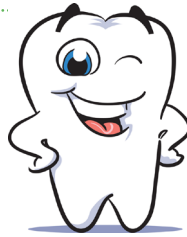
- Keep contact pick-up lists and phone numbers updated with the front office.
- Enroll your student in before-care if they need to be dropped off prior to 7:30am.
- Always park your vehicle and walk your student to the office if they are late for school
- Use the carloop and keep your vehicle off side roads, sidewalks, and grassy areas at arrival and dismissal.
- Obey carloop signs and drive carefully – refrain from cell phone use, follow the 5 mph speed limit and do not make left turns at the school exit during morning arrival.
- Always sign in and out through the front office while visiting or volunteering.
- Present a photo ID when picking up a student
- For the safety of ALL students, student checkouts must occur before 2 p.m. on the Lower Campus and before 3:15 p.m. on the Upper Campus
- All visits, appointments, and volunteer work must be pre-arranged and approved by the classroom teacher

(Brevard Public Schools Student Code of Conduct):

### Accessories

1. Jewelry and accessories shall not convey messages that are crude; vulgar/profane; violent/death-oriented; gang related; sexually suggestive; and/or promoting alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.

2. Pierced jewelry shall be limited to the ear. Dog collars, tongue rings, wallet chains, large hair picks, chains that connect one part of the body to another, or other jewelry/accessories that pose a safety concern for the student or others shall be prohibited.
