

## Directions for Classroom Access for Quarantined Students

During the 2021-2022 school year, teachers are being asked to temporarily deliver instruction remotely using Canvas and Zoom for students needed to be home for quarantine. Canvas can be accessed through the school's Launchpad accessed via ClassLink. Zoom meeting rooms will be accessed via a link posted in the teacher's Canvas course.

Below is the instructional model that teachers will use to provide students with quality instruction when in-person classes are interrupted.

- 1) Teachers will provide quarantined students with a Zoom link to their personal Zoom meeting room which will be posted in the teacher's Canvas course(s) for students to join the classroom.
  - Attendance will not be taken from the Zoom "window" into the classroom.
  - Teachers will not engage (audio/video/chat) with or monitor students while they are viewing the classroom from home using Zoom.
  - Students are to communicate questions and/or concerns through the Canvas messenger.
  - Zoom meeting room will remain open during the entire class period/day.
- 2) Teacher will provide the lessons and courses necessary to complete the curriculum through their Canvas course.

In some instances, when a teacher is in quarantine, the teacher will continue to provide instruction to students via Zoom. Students will use the same link to the Zoom meeting room found on the teacher's Canvas course.
