Band Rehearsal Going Strong

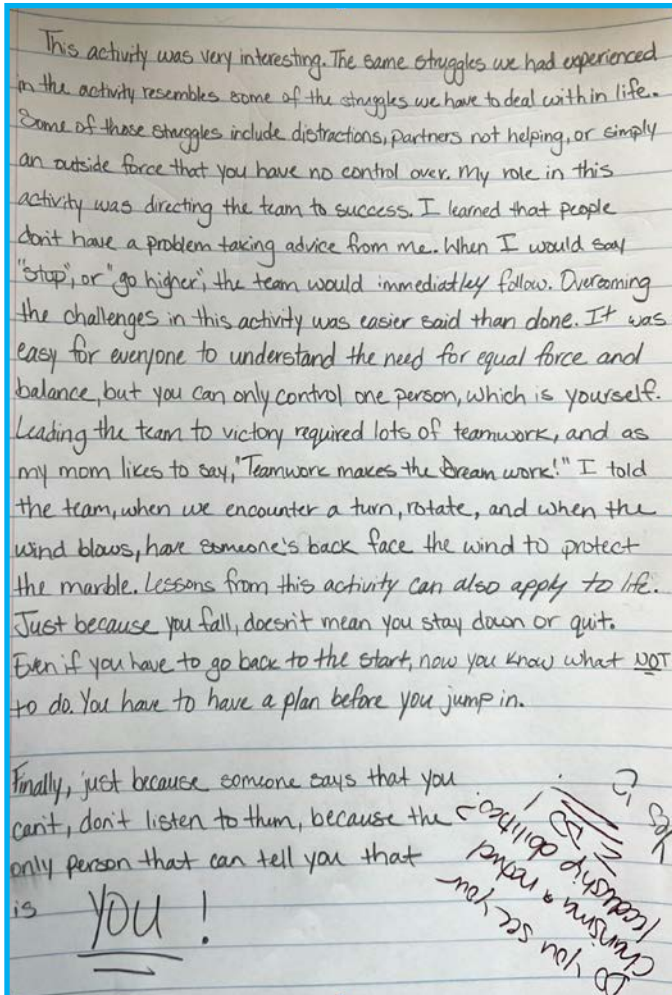
Band Director, Marli Kevelin, and her students were hard at work practicing for their Music Performance Assessment at Eau Gallie High School on March 9th.

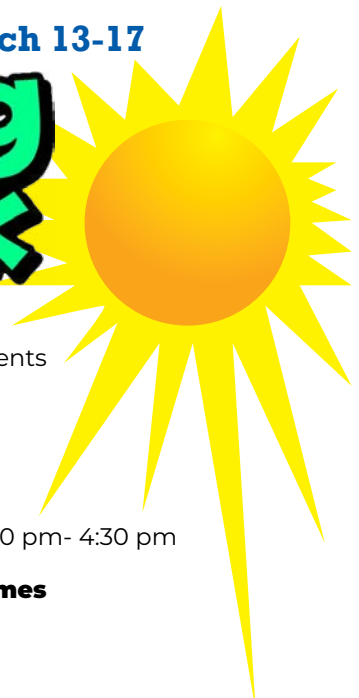

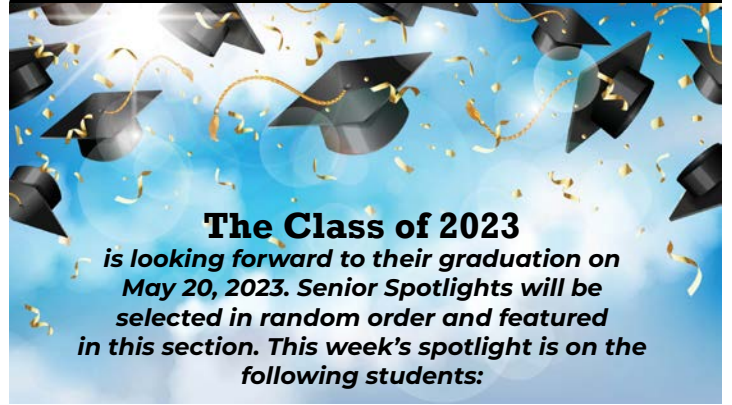
